III APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion by Trustee Medema, seconded by Trustee Kaupas, to approve the June 11, 2020, minutes of the Regular Meeting as corrected. No further discussion; all voted in favor, none opposed; motion carried.

IV BOARD ACTION ITEMS

Supervisor Hickey reported that the emergency tower at Airway Court was not operable and needed to be replaced. Each year one of the four communication towers needs replacement at a cost of \$3,052.00 and the same will be replaced at Township expense.

V SUPERVISOR'S REPORT

The New Lenox Township Meals on Wheels program which was being prepared at Frankfort Township, will be distributed from the basement of New Lenox Senior Center food center. And volunteers will pick up those meals from the basement of the senior center and deliver them to homebound seniors. Supervisor Hickey also stated that in keeping with sanitizing efforts our crews have been fogging our facilities and vehicles with sanitizing materials.

VI TRUSTEE REPORTS

Trustee Boban reports that the electronics recycling program has been successfully run by Will County. Trustee Boban also stated that the township's mosquito abatement program is ready to spray when mosquito larvae are observed in the township. Trustee Boban also stated that he received numerous comments from the public at the 4th Of July Parade that essential township services including the food pantry and transportation services are very well received by the township citizens and appreciated. Trustee Boban also noted that our Friday grocery deliveries which go directly to our basement of housing for seniors which are delivered by volunteers is appreciated. The Trustee is pleased to announce the Veteran Thomas Zolecki has been added to our Veterans web page of our web site.

Trustee Kaupas reported that a donation of \$1,000 has been received from former Chicago White Sox baseball player Ron Kittle to purchase food items for the needy residents of the Township for which we are grateful and thankful.

Trustee Hilton reported that our transportation department has done a great job in providing transportation for those citizens in need of transportation for medical and grocery shopping needs because they are unable to otherwise do so.
